After more than ten years of project development Krieger Projektentwicklungs GmbH, the owners of the former freight yard in Pankow, reached an agreement with the Berlin senate and the district of Pankow about tendering a competition for the site in 2020. The result was a procedure involving online consultation with the general public. The winners chosen in autumn 2021 were Noefer Architekten, together with CKSA, Fugmann Janotta Landschaftsarchitekten and Stadt+Verkehr. This master plan now serves as the basis for a draft development plan is envisioned as an quarter with residential buildings and various mixed uses. A new shopping precinct next to Pankow S-Bahn

station will also provide office space and apartments for students and senior citizens on the upper floors. Along the new tram route, residential blocks will offer new attractive urban space. The two parks which flank the new railway line and the Panke Trail express will be open to the public. Next to the planned furniture retailer at the north-east end of the new quarter, two high-rise buildings will build a "gate" on Prenzlauer Promenade. The project's urban design deliberately draws on early twentieth-century reform architecture which is to be found in the neighbourhood.
